Thierry Weissenburger is Consul and Senior Trade Commissioner at the Consulate General of Canada in San Francisco-Silicon Valley since February 2008. He was previously posted for four years in Copenhagen, as head of the Canadian Commercial Program for Denmark and home ruled territories. In his position, he was also Canadian Science and Technology Coordinator for the Nordic countries, supporting Canadian research organizations and businesses developing S&T collaborative projects throughout the Nordic countries.

Before joining the Canadian Embassy, Thierry was Deputy Director at the Science and Technology Division of the Department of Foreign Affairs and International Trade (DFAIT). His responsibilities included the management of Canada's key bilateral and multilateral Science and Technology (S&T) files and the coordination of the S&T Counselors network posted at Canadian Embassies abroad, with a view to advance Canada's economic interests. In previous assignments, Thierry Weissenburger was also involved in the management of international S&T relations at the National Research Council of Canada (NRC) and, subsequently, at the Natural Sciences and Engineering Research Council (NSERC).

Thierry Weissenburger holds an MBA-Research from the University of Quebec in Montreal with a specialization in Management of Innovation and International Affairs. He also holds a B.A. in Administration and a university degree in chemistry
